## **BACKGROUND:**

Y-DNA test results matching the Y111 modal haplotype or genetic signature of Peter Staple (c1642-1719) Piscataqua Pioneer, within a satisfactory genetic distance tells us that we have a genetic family tree relationship to Peter. Our Y-DNA test result does not tell us with Who, Where or When the transmission event took place.

Preliminary test data of the family branch mutations may tell us which branch of the tree (which son of Peter) you descend from. However, without Y111-DNA test results for each branch at each generation only a proven pedigree can give us our complete lineage. Thus, genealogical information is required for each generation proving the family relationship of the child to the lineage carrier for a proven pedigree.
